

### Aims

Marlborough US Multi-Cap Income is a cell of Marlborough International Fund PCC Limited, a Class B collective investment scheme authorised by the Guernsey Financial Services Commission. The investment objective of the Cell is to obtain a growing level of income with the potential for some capital growth by acting as a feeder fund into the Marlborough US Multi-Cap Income Cell, an actively managed UCITS fund authorised by the Financial Conduct Authority. ### Philosophy

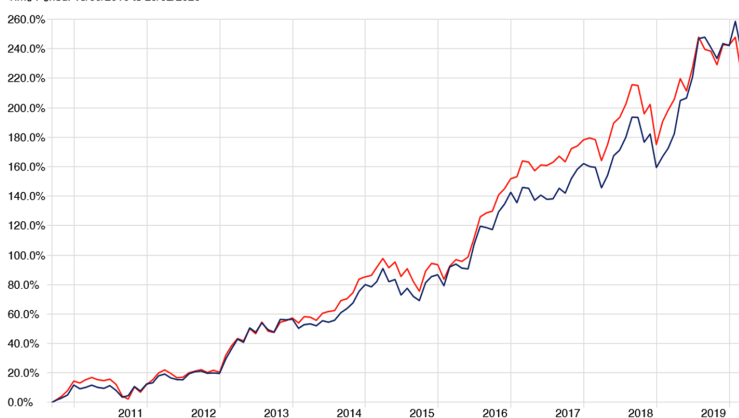
The fund follows an income growth strategy on the premise that dividend paying US companies have outperformed the wider market over the long term.

Key points:

- Concentrated portfolio of 30-40 stocks
- Income oriented, targets growing dividends
- Invest in mispriced, high quality companies
  - Focused on fundamentally sound companies with strong brands, able to generate high returns and free cash flow, and have a sustainable competitive advantage
  - Target businesses with excellent management teams that are shareholder friendly
  - Look to identify reason for mispricing, purchase below our assessment of worth when we see a catalyst to unlock value
- Long-term time horizon
  - Five year view when making investments
  - Avoid typical myopic views, looking for compounding shareholder value through cycles.
